If nominating heifer as both commercial and market, please submit both the "Market Beef" and "Commercial Heifer" nomination forms by the market heifer deadline of May 1 with one DNA sample and one \$8 nomination fee per heifer. If submitted separately, you will be charged for two nominations.

Guidelines:

- Commercial Heifers must be tagged with official 4-H/FFA beef ear tag by June 15. Tag number must be listed on nomination form.
- **All** commercial heifers **must have a unique, individual, and legible tattoo in at least one ear by June 15.** Tattoo must be listed on nomination form.
- Nomination must be postmarked by June 15. Heifers born in the current year are not eligible to show.

CHECKLIST

COMMERCIAL BREEDING HEIFER NOMINATION

I have a commercial heifer to nominate, what do I need to turn in?

Completed Household Declaration Form (www.YouthLivestock.KSU.edu). Double check that no field has been left blank or incomplete. If you have marked “No” for the housing question in Section 1, you must complete Section 2, including listing the species and how you will care for projects not located at your primary residence.

Tagged Your Animal by June 15 with a Kansas 4-H Electronic Identification (EID) tag.

Completed Commercial Heifer Nomination Form (www.YouthLivestock.KSU.edu) including all contact information, signatures, tag number, birthday, and tattoo. Make sure 4-H tag number on form matches DNA envelope.

Completed DNA Hair Sample Envelope, in an official, sealed envelope; hair must be pulled, not cut. Obtain at least 40 follicles. All family exhibitors and a parent/guardian must sign the front of the DNA envelope.

Tattoo – Heifer must be identified with an individual, unique permanent tattoo and this must be listed on the commercial heifer nomination form. Bangs tattoos are not acceptable. The tattoo listed on the form **MUST** match the tattoo in the heifer’s ear to be eligible to show.

\$8.00 per animal nomination fee. Make checks payable to KJLS.

All of the above must be completed and postmarked by **June 15**. Certified Mail highly encouraged.

Exhibitors who wish to participate in the Kansas State Fair Grand Drive or the Kansas Junior Livestock Show (KJLS) must complete the entry procedure set forth by each respective show.
