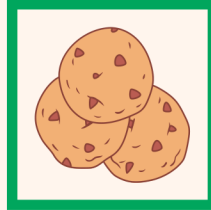
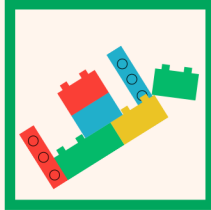


REGIONAL 4-H MOCK
