This upcoming Wednesday March 12<sup>th</sup>, K-State Research and Extension - Doniphan County will be hosting the annual Northeast Kansas Sheep and Goat School in Troy, KS. This event is an annual educational sheep and goat producer meeting that rotates throughout northeast Kansas Research and Extension units. This will be the first time in over four years that this free program returns to our community.

This evening meeting will begin at 6:00 pm with registration. Dr. Kelsey Bentley, K-State University Small Ruminant Extension Specialist, will speak on parasites and management strategies for sheep and goat producers at 6:30 pm.
